Governor's Executive Order (EO 147) Requires Face Coverings

Surf City, NC – On Wednesday, June 24th, North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper announced the continuation of the “Safer at Home Phase 2” until at least July 17th. The updated Executive Order (EO 147) continues all closures and mass gathering limits from Executive Order 141, which includes indoor gathering limitations of 10 and outdoor gatherings of 25. The updated Executive Order, effective Friday, June 26 at 5pm, also mandates the wearing of face coverings in public places indoors and outdoors with exceptions outlined within the Executive Order. As the weekend approaches and we get closer to the 4th of July Holiday, the Town of Surf City is asking that all residents and visitors do their part by following the Executive Orders to assure we continue to have a safe and enjoyable summer.
