



Vegetative Debris Pick-Up Guidelines

Town crews will begin to pick-up VEGETATIVE debris generated by Hurricane Isaias, on **Wednesday, August 12th**. Please have all VEGETATIVE debris out by this time. Crews will only go to each location once, after that, it is the property owner's responsibility to haul debris.

Vegetative Debris Separation & Removal Guidelines:

- ✓ Must be placed in the right-of-way within ten (10) feet of the edge of pavement (street) or back of curb. Vegetative debris that is outside of ten (10) feet will NOT be picked up.
- ✓ Vegetative debris should be no longer than four (4) feet in length and twelve (12) inches in diameter.
- ✓ Please DO NOT block sidewalks or driveways.
- ✓ Please remember - vegetative debris generated by HURRICANE ISAIAS ONLY should be placed near the road.
- ✓ Construction and Demolition debris will NOT be picked up. If you have C&D debris resulting from the storm, please dispose of it properly.

Pick Up Schedule:

- Island – South to North
- Mainland – Roland, Atkinson Point, Little Kinston, Driftwood, and all other roads in Town limits.
- Mainland - Subdivisions
